## 1:35pm Update: NE 82<sup>nd</sup> MAX Sculpture Revised Concept Proposal (35 min)

- Ivan revised concept and provided mockup; keeping the bright pop of magenta
- Hourglass shape to denote waiting (for transit); tree-like figure with nodes as a nod to hugging and togetherness
- Discussed 5ft (gallery size) vs 7ft (more presence); committee preference for larger
- Committee unanimously approved: recommend narrow plinth to deter climbing and include label/plaque to explain artist concept

## 2:05pm New Commissions (45 min) Michael Corrente

- Garage, Layover and Transit Center (TC) Expansions Project
   Overdue for updating designs; goal of increasing function, accessibility with
   Universal Design approach; project 50% designed, 90% in June
- Oregon City TC is directly on Main Street
  - rebuilding operator break building, bus parking/loading, add sidewalks
  - Committee would like to see more context from pedestrian stand point; elevation (not currently available)
  - 3 potential art locations, preference for 1-2 wall treatments, less sculpture since it's likely to compete with new bus shelter
  - Looking for bright colors, tactile textured pattern; wall treatment will help make more "friendly" building
- Michelle will reach out to Clackamas County Arts Alliance for feedback and input on Oregon City TC before RFQ goes out

- Beaverton TC is more isolated from surroundings, improvements include converting bike shed into operator break building, adding electric bus charging equipment and increasing accessibility/safety
  - art opportunity on for cut metal, flatwork panels to shroud new equipment
  - consider honoring the land itself, ex. bird flyway
- Tentative schedule- RFQ review January 2025, with Artist Selection in April 2025
